- Innovation Action (IA)

Both calls will be in two phases:

- PO (Project Outline) Compulsory and Gating
- FPP (Full Project Proposal)




## Calls 2017 Budget

## Two Budgets!!



#### **Current National Commitments**

- The process is ongoing
- Some states have not decided yet
- Confirmed commitments of 89.9M€ - half way from the Calls 2017 target (1:1 ratio at least).
- Recall the planned EU funding of 160M€

## Reimbursement rates (no changes)

The MAX funding percentages of the EU contribution are different than under H2020.

Туре	RIA	IA
For profit (non SME)	25%	20%
SME	30%	25%
University/Other	35%	35%

EU Contribution as % of the eligible cost according to H2020 (beneficiaries may ask for a lower contribution)

National contributions: vary per state, see the Annex of Work Plan 2017



#### **CAPPING**

#### <u>IA</u>

- The EU contribution <u>per project</u> is capped at 30M€
- the maximum contribution <u>per partner in a project is</u> limited to **50%** of the total EU funding for the project

#### <u>RIA</u>

- The EU contribution <u>per project</u> is capped at 15M€
- the maximum contribution <u>per partner</u> in a project is limited to **40%** of the total EU funding for the project

## The Project Outline

- Blocking if under threshold
- Participants, budgets: as complete and precise as possible
   ... BUT changes are possible afterwards, though limited!
- All 3 evaluation criteria (Sections 1. Excellence, 2. Impact, 3. Implementation) need to be filled in following the template.
- Fill in the other Sections <u>if available info</u>: 4. Members of the consortium; 5. Ethics and Security;
- Section 6. Publishable Summary (to be completed <u>for PO phase</u> do not forget it!!!)
- Expect feedback from national authorities (not from ECSEL)

## **NEW: Mandatory Page Limits**

- Use the default template and fonts!
  - Chapter EXCELLENCE 60 pages
  - Chapter IMPACT 100 pages
  - Chapter IMPLEMENTATION 100 pages
- Annex on Partners is excluded from the page limit
- The page limits and sections subject to limits will be clearly shown in the proposal templates.
- Expert evaluators will be instructed to disregard the excess pages.

Provide a right balance between general and detail.



### Proposal submission

- Register your company (PIC number)
- Use the portal to register your proposal (coordinator)

#### Proposal consists of:

**ECSEL JU** 

- Part A: consortium information including financial information (cost, funding)
- Part B: Pdf with technical description
- Part C: Country specific information required (specific for ECSEL) – check WP2017

## European Structural and Investment (ESI) Funding

- If activities with costs are funded through ESI funds, then those activities <u>cannot obtain</u>
   <u>ECSEL-EU funding</u>.
- Various possibilities to include activities funded by ESI funds described in the Guide for Applicants
- Main issue: no overlap
- Risk mitigation: what happens if the activity does not get the ESI funding?






- For both Calls

- Does not affect the evaluation of your proposal!
