- Resilience in systems of systems (handling faults, disturbances, unexpected events)
- Humans in the loop
- Towards cognitive systems: Data-based system operation.

The CPSoS Workshop shall mainly serve for presentations and discussions around these mediumterm research priorities. Besides, domain-specific topics for different areas shall be put forward.
